
## Osa – Replacing the Display Screen

Tools Required:

Torx T20 bit/key

5mm Allen Wrench


Step 1: Using a Torx T20, remove the 4 securing bolts for the front of the Osa main beam.



Step 2: Remove the front section of the main beam. Tip: Rest/Secure it on the front fender using a short strap or similar.



Step 3: Follow the cable from the back of the display to where it connects to the bike's main harness. Disconnect these two connections. Note: The 3<sup>rd</sup> connection is a data port that is unused during normal riding. No cause for concern!



Step 4: Take note of the handlebar position at this step, so you can be sure to re-install them in the same position. Using a 5mm Allen key, remove the four 5mm securing bolts on the upper stem. The display will then come completely off.



Step 6: Reverse the steps above for the installation of the new unit.
